**Materials:**

3 Tags	Bead Gallery® rondelle sapphire iris 3x4mm
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® blue glass luster drop 4x6mm
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® black glass oval 5x3mm
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® jet 4mm round glass
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® purple iris glass 3mm
3 Tags	Bead Gallery® small glass 3mm round faceted
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® rose glass rondelle 4x6mm
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® amethyst iris glass 6mm
1 Tag	Bead Gallery® purple glass iris rondelle
190"	Stretch Magic® .5mm beading cord

**Tools:**

Beadalon® wire nippers  
Super glue  
Bead Bugs®

Level of difficulty (Beginner)

**Time** – Less than 10 minutes per bracelet

**Tip:** Stretch cord before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the shape of your bracelet.

**Sapphire Iris Bracelets****Instructions:**

1. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
2. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
3. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
4. String 7" of sapphire iris beads.
5. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
6. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
7. Repeat steps 1-6 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> bracelets.

**Blue Glass Luster Drops bracelets****Instructions:**

8. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
9. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
10. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
11. String 27 blue glass luster drops.

12. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
13. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
14. Repeat steps 8-13 for 2<sup>nd</sup> bracelet.

#### Black glass oval bracelets

##### **Instructions:**

15. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
16. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
17. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
18. String 7" of black glass ovals.
19. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
20. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
21. Repeat steps 15-20 for 2<sup>nd</sup> bracelet.

#### Jet Round bracelets

##### **Instructions:**

22. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
23. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
24. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
25. String 7" of 4mm jet round beads.
26. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
27. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
28. Repeat steps 22-27 for 2<sup>nd</sup> bracelet.

#### Purple Iris bracelets

##### **Instructions:**

29. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
30. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
31. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
32. String 7" purple iris glass 3mm beads.
33. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
34. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
35. Repeat steps 29-34 for 2<sup>nd</sup> bracelet.

#### Silver 3mm bracelets

**Instructions:**

36. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
37. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
38. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
39. String 7" silver 3mm rounds.
40. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
41. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
42. Repeat steps 26-41 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> bracelets.

## Rose Rondelle bracelets

**Instructions:**

43. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
44. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
45. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
46. String 7" of rose glass rondelles.
47. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
48. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
49. Repeat steps 43-18 for 2<sup>nd</sup> bracelet.

## Amethyst Iris 6mm bracelets

**Instructions:**

50. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
51. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
52. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
53. String 29 amethyst iris 6mm beads.
54. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
55. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
56. Repeat steps 50-55 for 2<sup>nd</sup> bracelet.

## Purple Iris Rondelle bracelet

**Instructions:**

57. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
58. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
59. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
60. String 39 purple glass iris rondelles.

61. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
62. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
