

## Albany Bracelets

**Materials:**

1 Tag	Bead Gallery® natural mother of pearl 4mm
1 Tag	Bead Gallery® dyed howlite rondelle 4x6mm stone
1 Tag	Bead Gallery® light blue 6mm shell
1 Tag	Bead Gallery® aqua green quartzite round 6mm stone
25	Bead Gallery® shell aqua luster round 7mm
1	Charm Gallery® 14kt gold-plated starfish charm
1	Charm Gallery® 14kt gold-plated pineapple charm
1	Charm Gallery® 14kt gold-plated mermaid charm
1	Charm Gallery® 14kt gold-plated sun charm
1	Charm Gallery® 14kt gold-plated anchor charm
50"	Stretch Magic® .5mm beading cord
5	Bead Landing™ gold tone 2" eye pins

**Tools:**

Beadalon® wire nippers  
Super glue  
Bead Bugs®

Level of difficulty (Beginner)

**Time** – Less than 10 minutes per bracelet

**Tip:** Stretch cord before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the shape of your bracelet.



### Light Blue Shell Anchor Charm Bracelet

#### **Instructions:**

1. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
2. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
3. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
4. Using 2" eye pin, string light blue shell and form a simple loop.
5. Attach anchor charm to loop.
6. String 7" of light blue shell beads and light blue shell loop.
7. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
8. Hide knot inside of closest bead.

### Aqua Shell Luster Sun Charm Bracelet

#### **Instructions:**

9. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
10. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
11. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
12. Using 2" eye pin, string aqua shell luster and form a simple loop.
13. Attach sun charm to loop.
14. String 24 aqua shell luster beads and aqua shell luster loop.
15. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
16. Hide knot inside of closest bead.

### Howlite Rondelle Starfish Charm Bracelet

#### **Instructions:**

17. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
18. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
19. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
20. Using 2" eye pin, string howlite rondelle and form a simple loop.
21. Attach starfish charm to loop.
22. String 7" of howlite rondelles and howlite rondelle loop.
23. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
24. Hide knot inside of closest bead.

### Aqua Green Quartzite Pineapple Charm Bracelet

#### **Instructions:**

25. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.

26. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
27. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
28. Using 2" eye pin, string aqua green quartzite and form a simple loop.
29. Attach pineapple charm to loop.
30. String 7" of aqua green quartzite beads and aqua green quartzite loop.
31. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
32. Hide knot inside of closest bead.

#### Natural Mother of Pearl Mermaid Charm Bracelet

##### **Instructions:**

33. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
34. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
35. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
36. Using 2" eye pin, string natural mother of pearl and form a simple loop.
37. Attach mermaid charm to loop.
38. String 7" of natural mother of pearl beads and natural mother of pearl loop.
39. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
40. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
